- O-Track - Online assessment that enables the school to track progress against our newly implemented assessment guidelines.
- An increase to 3 learning mentors to carefully track and support our most disadvantaged children
- Citizen's Advice Bureau – rapid response for parents
- Speech and language support (The school employs a therapist and technician and we have purchased an assessment package from Wellcomm and Infant Link Screening to carefully monitor, track and assess those children who require language and speech support)
- Extra additional adult support utilising a range of interventions such as 1st class @ number, Racing To English and Memory Magic
- Curriculum enhancements including subsidised educational visits
- Subsidised Breakfast and After School clubs are also provided for our children
- Swimming lessons at a local sports centre are also provided for two of our year groups
- Additional staff are employed to provide 1:1 tuition
- A Residential trip is also provided for the children at Plas Doly-Moch
- CPOMS – This online safeguarding software enables staff to monitor the safety of our children and record and share any concerns that they may have.

All children entitled to Pupil Premium are clearly identified and are provided with additional interventions. These interventions are tracked to measure children's access to learning and the progress they make as a result.

At Spon Gate we are committed to going the extra mile for our pupils. As such, the school uses its resources to ensure that all children's basic needs are met.
